At this moment, Outcry is one incredible performance away from winning the entire competition and being crowned Live and Unsigned best Band or Solo act. Taking place in London, the Grand Final will showcase the best unsigned talent from all over the UK.

Live and Unsigned is a national music competition for unsigned acts and singers to compete live. It stands as the biggest music talent search in the UK for original music. The competition encourages the contestants to do their own thing; be individual, original, perform their own genre and style Live. Thus being the case, all contestants in the National Live and Unsigned Final are the most determined original and talented individuals from all over the UK.

The event will take place at Fairfield Halls, London on the 28<sup>th</sup> of June at 8.30pm. The finalists will be thrust into the media spotlight through television, radio and the press and furthermore winners will be invited on the UK Live and Unsigned Tour for 2009. For maximum exposure and publicity for all acts involved, the remaining regional finals and National Grand final will be filmed and broadcasted on SKY TV's new 'Red TV' channel. The program has been granted primetime broadcasting with time slots on Tuesday and Saturday evenings between 8-9pm starting from April the 22nd 2008.

Outcry will no doubt have their fan base galvanised to attend and support at the National Final, including eager family and friends to support their bid for this exciting opportunity. Representing the best of this region's talent, Outcry is hoping for all the regional support possible to be crowned the UK's best Live and Unsigned's Band or Solo act and be the Grand National winner.
